Internship Program

The Internship Program has paid opportunities for current students enrolled in high school through graduate school. Students must be enrolled at least half-time in an accredited high school, college, professional, technical, vocational, or trade school.

Student Volunteer Program

The Student Volunteer Employment Program hires students to work at FEMA as volunteers for valuable experience directly related to their academic field of study.

Recent Graduate Program

The Recent Graduate Programs has jobs for recent graduates who have completed within the previous two years, a qualifying associates, bachelors, masters, professional, doctorate, vocational, or technical degree or certificate from a qualifying educational institution.
