**FEMA's mission** is to help people before, during, and after disasters.

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#### **Veteran's Preference**

Veterans' Preference gives eligible veterans preference in appointment over many other applicants. Not all veterans are entitled to it. Typically, veterans must have served on active duty for at least 2 years during a period of war, be disabled, or meet other criteria.

## Veteran's Recruitment Appointment (VRA)

Under the VRA, eligible veterans may be hired up to the GS-11 or equivalent grade level. After satisfactorily completing two years of service, the individual is non competitively converted to a career or career conditional appointment.

# Veterans Employment Opportunities Act of 1998 (VEOA)

Permanent Full-Time (PFT) employees are hired through a competitive process that includes an evaluation of candidates' education, experience, and other attributes necessary for successful performance in the position to be filled. Permanent employees must complete a 1-year probationary period and a total of 3 years continuous creditable service to attend a career appointment.

### **30% or More Disabled Veterans**

Under this authority, eligible veterans may be hired into any position to which they are qualified without applying to vacancy announcement. Initial appointments are time-limited, lasting more than 60 days; however, individuals may be converted to a permanent appointment at any time during the time-limited appointment.
