

**MINUTES OF THE MARY WASHINGTON COLLEGE GENERAL FACULTY MEETING  
APRIL 17, 2002**

Dean Hall called the meeting to order at 4:07 p.m. in the Lee Hall Ballroom. Minutes of the March 13, 2002 meeting were approved as distributed in the agenda packet. In reference to the Faculty Senate Actions Taken on April 3, 2002 report Dr. Hall announced that there will be a meeting scheduled for September 2002 to address any faculty challenges to those actions.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

Dean Hall asked Ms. Barra, Marshall of the Faculty, to place the following motion before the faculty:

**Mr. Chairman, as Marshall of the Faculty of Mary Washington College, I move to recommend to you, the President, the Rector, and the Board of Visitors of Mary Washington College that the 375 candidates for the degree of Bachelor of Arts, the 382 candidates for the degree of Bachelor of Science, and the 94 candidates for the degree of Bachelor of Liberal Studies, to the sum of 851 candidates for baccalaureate degrees; and the 10 candidates for the degree of Master of Arts in Liberal Studies, whose names appear on the list before us, be awarded those degrees subject to final certification by the Office of the Registrar that all requirements are met; and that appropriate honors be awarded to those qualified for them by virtue of their academic standing or completed projects.**

The motion was seconded and passed.
