The Continuation of F. Jacoby's "Die Fragmente der griechischen Historiker": F. Jacoby's *Die Fragmente der griechischen Historiker* is a collection of and commentary on the fragments of ancient historiographical writing in Greek. The work is an indispensable tool for all scholars studying Antiquity, given the great preponderance of writings which have not been preserved over those that have withstood the test of time

(the so-called "shipwreck" of ancient historiography and, for that matter, ancient literature in general). Monumental though the collection is in its present state, it was nevertheless unfinished at the time of its creator's death in 1959.

Jacoby managed to complete the first three parts out the six he had planned, namely

- (I) Genealogy and Mythography
- (II) Zeitgeschichte (Jacoby's idiosyncratic term for the most prominent genre, viz. political-military history), and
- (III) Horography and Ethnography

The research unit Ancient Greek and Roman Historiography is one of the founding members of an international project (other collaborating universities are Bern, Göttingen, Harvard, Köln and Mannheim) aiming to realize the publication of part IV of FGrHist, which is to contain:

- (IV) Biography, literary history and antiquarian writings.

In the current, first phase of the undertaking the fragments of ancient Greek biographical writing (FGrHist IVA) are in the focus of attention. A series of eight chronologically arranged fascicles – each providing a critical edition, with English translation and commentary, of the surviving fragments – has been planned. They are the following:

A new up-to-date version is planned for the papyrologists conference in Vienna 2001. Egypt will be more clearly separated from the rest of the Greco-Roman world; Latin texts will be fully included on the basis of LOWE, *Codices Latini Antiquiores*; references to published plates and to internet sites will be updated.
