Most Commonly Asked Question: Why must I pay for damage outside of my room?

Your Housing and Dining Services contract you signed indicates that you have agreed to our common area damage policy. Please see your contract booklet, p 6, section "Damage Assessments." Essentially, if there is a loss/damage to common areas of any residence hall and UMW cannot identify the individual(s) responsible, the hall community (a section, floor, or entire building) will be assessed a prorated group charge covering the costs of repairs, replacement, reinstallation, or extra cleaning. If you or other students who reside in the building have information as to the individual(s) responsible, we will investigate the matter, and if possible, adjust your account appropriately. You will need to provide us, in writing, the information necessary to conduct such an investigation.
