

Scholarship Opportunities 2009-2010 Academic Year

The Office of Financial Aid would like to invite all currently enrolled students to apply to the following scholarship opportunities for the 2009-2010 Academic Year.

General Requirements:

Submit a copy of an unofficial current transcript (new freshman applicants for fall 2009 need not submit a transcript), letter of introduction, Scholarship Information Form (attached to this email) and documentation of any additional criteria listed below.

All items must be submitted by 5:00 PM on May 29, 2009. Scholarships will be awarded at the end of June. Individuals not selected to receive an award will not be notified. Applications must be complete to be considered for any of the scholarships.

Alvey Honor Scholarship

1. Junior or Senior from any discipline
2. Minimum 3.00 GPA
3. Demonstrate service in implementing the Honor System and maintaining its principles. ***Must have a letter of reference or documentation.***

Coleman Family Farm

1. Must be a full time Mary Washington rising junior student majoring in mathematics, physics, chemistry or business.
2. Special consideration shall be given to students from Virginia working farm families. ***Must provide documentation.***
3. The recipient shall be a student with demonstrated financial need and in good academic standing at the end of the sophomore year.

Fredericksburg Rotary Scholarship

1. Have demonstrated financial need based on FAFSA
2. Must be a resident of the City of Fredericksburg or the counties of Spotsylvania, Stafford, King George, or Caroline
3. Preference will be given to a student whose parent or parents are Rotarians.

Thomas and JoAnn Houser Scholarship

1. Must be an entering freshman in fall 2008 with demonstrated financial need.
2. Must have achieved at least a 3.0 during high school career.
3. Must possess high ethical standards and have demonstrated commitment to community service and leadership qualities in secondary school. The recipient also should show promise for providing service and leadership to the College and its community in the future. ***Must provide references and documentation of community service.***

4. Must work in a job at least 7 hours per week during the College's academic year, in order to help contribute to his or her educational expenses.

Jeannine Mary Pfeifle Memorial Scholarship

1. Must be full-time, residential, seniors during the 2009-2010 academic year who have been continuously enrolled at UMW since their freshman year
2. Must be citizens of the US, and specifically, in descending order of priority: the daughter or son of a US Marine or Navy service man
3. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.70
4. Must have demonstrated positive qualities of campus citizenship. *Documentation or letter of reference must be included in application.*

Sodexo Company Scholarship

1. Must demonstrate Academic Excellence at UMW (Minimum 3.00 GPA)
2. *Must have documentation of Community Service Involvement (Preference to COAR Volunteers)*

Ukrop's Super Markets/First Market Bank Scholarship

1. Must be enrolled, as a full time student, in an undergraduate degree program at the University of Mary Washington.
2. Must reside in the Commonwealth of Virginia
3. *Must possess characteristics of leadership and a personal commitment to ethical behavior based upon letters of reference from guidance counselors or teachers.*

Nettie & Charles Wiley Scholarship

1. The recipients shall be interested in early childhood education. (Please provide a signed essay stating your interest.)
2. Preference shall be given to students from Lancaster County or other sections of the Northern Neck of Virginia.

CJ and Hazel Small Wilkins

1. Must be a Junior or Senior Psychology/Sociology Major
2. Must have a Minimum 3.00 GPA
3. Must have demonstrated financial need based on FAFSA
4. *Must have documentation of Community Service Involvement (Preference to COAR Volunteers)*
