The Office of Financial Aid would like to invite students to apply for the following available scholarships. Students must complete a separate application for each scholarship. The application should include the Scholarship Application Form (included on this email), a current unofficial transcript (new freshman for fall 2009 are exempt), and any other documents specified with the scholarship criteria below. Additionally, each applicant should have a completed [Scholarship Information Form](#) on file with the Office of Financial Aid (only required once and available on the Financial Aid website at [www.umw.edu/financialaid](http://www.umw.edu/financialaid).) Please submit all application items no later than 5:00 pm on October 23, 2009 for consideration. Award notifications will be mailed by November 1, 2009 for students who are awarded a scholarship.

**Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.**

**BBT for BPS Scholarship**

1. The recipient must be a degree candidate for the Bachelor of Professional Studies program at the Center for Graduate and Professional Studies (CGPS) campus.
2. Students must retain an overall cumulative grade point average of 3.000 at the University of Mary Washington.

**Application should contain a signed and dated letter-describing student's leadership positions or experience and personal commitments to ethical behavior.**

**Frances Holsclaw Brown '44 Scholarship**

1. Must be an entering freshman in fall 2009 with demonstrated financial need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)..
2. Must be a native Virginian.
3. The recipient must have plans to pursue an education in business administration or related field.
4. Preference will be given to students who work in food service positions on the University of Mary Washington campus.

**Application should contain a signed and dated short letter-describing student's educational goals.**

### **Coleman Family Farm**

1. Must be a full time Mary Washington junior student majoring in mathematics, physics, chemistry or business.
2. Special consideration shall be given to students from Virginia working farm families. ***Must provide documentation.***
3. The recipient shall be a student with demonstrated financial need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and be in good academic standing.

### **Amanda Elizabeth Dresser '95 Scholarship**

1. Student must have demonstrated need as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
2. Student must be a freshman, sophomore, or junior with a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
3. Student must possess a personal commitment to physical fitness.

***Must provide references that document commitment to physical fitness. References cannot be provided by a UMW coach or athletic director.***

### **David A. Hawkens '82 Scholarship**

Scholarship awarded to a student in good standing at the University of Mary Washington who demonstrates the characteristics of citizenship and public service.

***Students must provide documentation of Community Service Involvement and two letters of reference.***

### **Thomas and JoAnn Houser Scholarship**

1. Must be an entering freshman in fall 2009 with demonstrated financial need as determined by the Free Application for federal student aid (FAFSA).
2. Must have achieved at least a 3.0 during high school career.
3. Must possess high ethical standards and have demonstrated commitment to community service and leadership qualities in secondary school. The recipient also should show promise for providing service and leadership to the College and its community in the future.
4. Must work in a job at least 7 hours per week during the College's academic year.

***Must provide references and documentation of community service.***

### **Jeannine Mary Pfeifle Memorial Scholarship**

1. Must be a full-time, residential senior who has been continuously enrolled, and resided on campus, at UMW since the freshman year.
2. Must be citizens of the US, and specifically, in descending order of priority: the daughter or son of a US Marine or Navy service man or woman.
3. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.700
4. Must have demonstrated positive qualities of campus citizenship.

**Students must provide documentation of parent Marine or Navy service.**

### **Sodexo Company Scholarship**

1. Must demonstrate Academic Excellence at UMW (Minimum 3.00 GPA)

**Must have documentation of Community Service Involvement (Preference to COAR Volunteers)**

### **Ukrop's Super Markets/First Market Bank Scholarship**

1. Must be enrolled as a full time student in an undergraduate degree program at the University of Mary Washington.
2. Must reside in the Commonwealth of Virginia

**Students must provide two letters of reference describing student's characteristics of leadership and personal commitment to ethical behavior.**

### **Nettie & Charles Wiley Scholarship**

1. The recipients must be interested in early childhood education
2. Preference shall be given to students from Lancaster County or other sections of the Northern Neck of Virginia.

**Must provide a letter of reference and signed letter describing interest in early childhood education.**

### **Alvey Honor Scholarship**

1. Student must be a Junior or Senior from any discipline
2. Must have a minimum 3.00 GPA
3. Student must demonstrate service in implementing the Honor System and maintaining its principles.

**Application should include two letters of reference and a letter describing student's service to the honor system.**

### **Fredericksburg Rotary Scholarship**

1. Students must have demonstrated financial need as determined by the Free Application for federal student aid (FAFSA).
2. Must be a resident of the City of Fredericksburg or the counties of Spotsylvania, Stafford, King George, or Caroline
3. Preference will be given to a student whose parent or parents are Rotarians. **Please provide documentation.**
