Services to the Public

UMW Libraries provides services and houses collections at two locations, the CGPS Stafford Library (2nd Floor, South Building on the Stafford Campus) and the Simpson Library (Fredericksburg Campus). Both libraries are open to the public.

What's Available at the CGPS Stafford Library?

The CGPS Stafford Library collection includes books and periodicals in the fields of business and education and a children's literature collection. The Library provides the perfect environment for individual and group study, with large tables and computer workstations equipped with Microsoft Office and access to the web. Members of the public are welcome to use library computers. Printing and copying are also available in the library.

Checking Out Books

Residents of Virginia over the age of eighteen may apply for a Guest Patron card at the Circulation Desk at Simpson Library. Upon satisfactory completion of the application and a payment (cash or check) of \$75.00, a Guest Patron card will be issued at the EagleOne Card Center. The card entitles the Guest Patron to borrowing privileges for one year. Members of the public without a Guest Patron card are welcome to browse and use our collections within the library. Members of the public are also encouraged to use the Interlibrary Loan services at their public or institution library to request items from our collections.

What Online Resources are Available to the Public?

24/7 online access to the Libraries' Catalog and Journal Finder are available both on and off campus via the Libraries' website at <http://www.umw.edu/library>. The public can also use over 100 online research databases from computers within the library; off-campus access to databases is restricted to UMW students, faculty and staff.
