*** The committee recommends that a faculty committee study the establishment of programs in Regional Studies (which may include African, Asian, Latin American, and Middle Eastern Studies) and Interdisciplinary Studies (which may include Women's, Gender, African-American, and Southern Studies) within the first five years. The faculty committee should decide which programs the Fredericksburg campus should devise based on existing faculty expertise and interest. These programs could be implemented as a department or an interdisciplinary program; the committee recommends the latter. The committee further recommends that the faculty committee, in the first five years, look into establishing a Center to coordinate these programs.
