Total Sample: N=1,000; Likely Voters [LVS] n=528

N=600 phone (80 percent cell; 20 percent landline), N=400 web

Age, gender and race/ethnicity were weighted.

The margin of error on the total sample is +/- 3.1%. The margin of error on "Likely Voters" is +/- 4.1%.

Less than 0.5% is rounded to zero.
