1. 2012 Dashboard Data

Taiwo Ande, Associate Provost for Institutional Analysis and Effectiveness

- A presentation was given that showed updates to the Dashboard statistics (available at umw.edu), focusing on data extracted between 2010 and 2011.

- Enrollment data comparisons were made between the University of Mary Washington, the Council of Public Liberal Arts Colleges (COPLAC), Aspirational Peers, Virginia 4-year schools, and Virginia private schools. Future reports will include Admitted Student Questionnaire (ASQ) data.
- Discussion was held regarding current enrollment trends and student demographic data, which will be used when creating the first-year experience model.
- An exit survey will be reinitiated for graduating students next year. Alumni statistical data will help in the recruitment of new students.
